# History

#### • 2007:

- Issues raised about national agenda for ethnic minorities
  - Proposed resolution about African-American reaching parity in IT
- Recognition of common themes of ethnic minorities and people with disabilities
- Started talking about holding a workshop to have move toward a national agenda and national-scale projects
- 2008
  - Organized a workshop, with 24 attendees representing national organizations, BPC projects, local projects and industry
  - Developed a mission for CMD-IT
  - Received funding for a Boys & Girls Clubs Project involving CSDTs and CityStroll
  - Held monthly calls among the five of us
- 2009
  - Moved to bi-weekly calls to get things moving forward
  - Developed the CMD-IT website
  - Held BOF at Tapia 2009, which was well received
- 2010
  - Launched CMD-IT
  - Launched Community of Practice
  - Organized a Board of Advisors
  - Here we are today, focused on the strategic plan



## **CMD-IT Goals**

- Focus on all under-represented groups (African Americans, Hispanics, Native Americans, Pacific Islanders, and People with Disabilities) to build synergies that result in:
  - Linkages for national-scale efforts
  - National agenda for transformative changes
  - Organized leadership initiatives
